




# CAUTION! If a 13 amp (BS1363) plug is used, a 3 amp fuse (BS1362) must be fitted.

If the colours of the wires in the mains lead of this product do not correspond with the coloured markings identifying the terminals in your plug, proceed as follows:

- The blue wire must be connected to the terminal marked with the letter **N** or coloured black.
- The brown wire must be connected to the terminal marked with the letter L or coloured red.
- No connection must be made to the earth terminal inside the plug.









# **REMOTE CONTROL**

#### **BATTERY INSTALLATION (Battery not Supplied )**

INSERT BATTERIES INTO THE REMOTE CONTROL BATTERY COMPARTMENT FOLLOWING THE POLARITY (+-) INDICATED. THE REMOTE CONTROL REQUIRE 2 X 1,5 " AAA " BATTERY FOR OPERATION (WE RECOMMEND TO USE A GOOD BRAND ALKALINE BATTERIES )

## 1. POWER U BUTTON

PRESS TO SWITCHING ON/STANDBY THE SYSTEM

#### 2. DISC-CH

PRESS TO ROTATE THE DISC TRAY IN CLOCKWISE

#### 3. MEMORY BUTTON

TO ACTIVE "MEMORY" MODE FOR CD PROGRAMMING

#### 4. PLAY►/PAUSE BUTTON

TO START PLAYING THE DISC AND INTERRUPT THE DISC PLAY AS DESIRED

#### 5. SKIP I SEARCH SEARCH SACKWARD BUTTON

PRESS TO SKIP/SEARCH DOWN OF CD DURING PLAYBACK

#### 6. SKIP ➡ SEARCH ➡ FORWARD BUTTON

PRESS TO SKIP/SEARCH UP OF CD DURING PLAYBACK

#### 7. STOP BUTTON

PRESS TO STOP THE PAYBACK OF CD OR CANCEL THE MEMORY/RANDOM FUNCTION AT CD MODE

#### 8. VOL +/- BUTTON

TO CONTROL THE VOLUME AT CD/VCD MODE

#### 9. **MUTE**

PRESS TO ACTIVE MUTE FUNCTION

#### MAINS (AC) OPERATION



# POWER SUPPLY

REMOVE THE STEREO CAREFULLY FORM THE BOX, RETAIN THE PACKAGING FOR FUTURE USE.

#### **AC POWER OPERATION**

CONNECT THE PLUG TO A MAINS POWER INLET 240V AC~50Hz

# IMPORTANT

SINCE MOVEMENT OF THE CD MECHANISM AND THE SENSITIVE CIRCUITY MAY CAUSE INTERFERENCE TO THE RADIO TUNER NEARBY, SWITCH THIS UNIT OFF WHILE OPERATING OTHER RADIO DEVICES.

# INSTALLATION

- UNPACK ALL PARTS AND REMOVE PROTECTIVE MATERIAL.
- DO NOT CONNECT THE UNIT TO THE MAINS BEFORE CHECKING THE MAINS VOLTAGE AND BEFORE ALL OTHER CONNECTIONS HAVE BEEN MADE.
- DO NOT COVER ANY VENTS AND MAKE SURE THAT THERE IS A SPACE OF SEVERAL CENTIMETERS AROUND THE UNIT FOR VENTILATION.

# CONNECTION

- CONNECT THE SPEAKER COLOUR CODED WIRES TO THE SPEAKER TERMINAL LOCATED AT THE BACK OF THE UNIT
- BEFORE CONNECTING THE POWER PLUG. BE SURE THE SWITCH AT THE POWER WALL OUTLET IS IN OFF POSITION.
- 3. CONNECT THE POWER CORD TO AC~240V 50Hz INTO THE WALL OUTLET.
- 4. 5. SWITCH BACK ON THE POWER AT THE WALL OUTLET.
- THE UNIT WILL GO INTO STANDBY MODE.
- TURN ON THE POWER AND SELECT " CD " FUNCTION. IF THE LCD DISPLAY IS ON WITH BACKLIGHTING, 6. IT'S MEAN THE POWER SUPPLY IS NORMAL. NOW YOUR SYSTEM IS READY TO PLAY THE MUSIC.

# LISTENING TO RADIO

#### **OPERATION**

- 1. SET THE FUNCTION SELECTOR TO "RADIO" POSITION.
- 2. SELECT THE DESIRED RADIO FREQUENCY BAND FROM BAND SELECTOR.
- TURN THE TUNING CONTROL, TO SET THE DESIRED RADIO STATION. 3.
- 4. ADJUST VOLUME CONTROLS FOR THE DESIRED VOLUME LEVEL.

# **FM & FM-STEREO RECEPTION**

- SET THE FM MODE SELECTOR AT " FM " POSITION. PROGRAMS ARE RECEIVED IN MONO MODE. IN PARTICULAR WHEN STEREO SIGNALS ARE WEAK. IT IS PREFERABLE TO RECEIVE THE PROGRAM IN MONO
- SET THE FM MODE SELECTOR AT "FM-ST "POSITION FOR RECEIVING STEREO PROGRAMS. THE STEREO LED INDICATOR WILL LIGHT UP TO SHOW FM STEREO PROGRAM IS RECEIVING.

# HINTS FOR BEST RECEPTION

- AM: THE RECEIVER HAS A BUILT-IN ANTENNA. IF THE AM RECEPTION IS WEAK, SLIGHT ROTATE OR RE-POSITIONING THE UNIT, FOR BETTER AM RECEPTION.
- FM: THE RECEIVER HAS A FM WIRE ANTENNA, HANGING AT THE REAR CABINET. THIS WIRE SHOULD BE TOTALLY UNRAVELED AND EXTENDED FOR BEST RECEPTION.

# PHONO

- REMOVE THE STYLUS PROTECTOR.
- BE SURE THAT THE TONE ARM IS BEING DETACHED FROM THE TONE ARM REST BEFORE OPERATING, AND RE-SECURED AGAIN AFTERWARDS.
- 1. PRESS THE " PHONO " FUNCTION SWITCH.
- 2. SET THE SPEED SELECTOR TO THE PROPER POSITION DEPENDING ON THE RECORD TO BE PLAYED.
- 3. PLACE THE RECORD ON THE PLATTER (USE THE SPINDLE ADAPTOR IF REQUIRED).
- 4. LIFT THE TONE ARM FROM THE REST AND SLOWLY MOVE IT TO THE RECORD SIDE. THE PLATTER WILL BEGIN TO ROTATE.
- 5. PLACE THE TONE ARM TO THE DESIRED POSITION OF THE RECORD.
- 6. ADJUST THE VOLUME TO THE DESIRED LEVEL.
- 7. AT THE END OF RECORD, THE PLATTER WILL AUTOMATICALLY STOP **P** ROTATING. LIFT THE TONE ARM FROM THE RECORD AND RETURN IT TO THE REST.
- 8. TO STOP MANUALLY, LIFT THE TONE ARM FROM THE RECORD AND RETURN IT TO THE REST.

**REMARK** : AS SOME KIND OF RECORD THE AUTO-STOP AREA WAS OUT OF THE UNIT SETTING, SO IT WILL STOP BEFORE THE LAST RACK FINISH. IN THIS CASE, SELECT THE AUTO-STOP SWITCH TO "OFF "POSITION, THEN IT WILL RUN TO THE END OF THE RECORD BUT WILL NOT STOP AUTOMATICALLY (TURN OFF THE UNIT BY POWER BUTTON OR SWITCH BACK THE AUTO-STOP SWITCH TO "ON " POSITION TO STOP THE PLATTER ROTATE). THEN PUT BACK THE TONE ARM TO THE REST POSITION.

# PLAYING COMPACT DISC

#### **GETTING START**

- 1. SELECT "CD" FUNCTION.
- 2. PRESS "OPEN/CLOSE" BUTTON TO OPEN THE CD DOOR.
- 3. PLACE A CD WITH THE PRINTED SIDE FACING UP INSIDE THE TRAY.
- 4. PRESS THE " <sup>()</sup>) " OR " DISC-CH " BUTTON TO TURNING THE CD TRAY, AND LOADING OUT THE OTHER DISC COMPARMENT.
- 5. PRESS THE "OPEN/CLOSE" BUTTON TO CLOSE THE CD DOOR.
- 6. CD SEARCH IS PERFORMING, AND THE 1<sup>ST</sup> DEDECTED DISC WILL BE STARTED PLAYBACK AUTOMATICALLY.
- **NOTE**: CD SEARCHING WILL BE PERFORMED EVERY TIME WHEN SWITCHING TO CD MODE OR CLOSING THE CD DOOR.

#### PLAY / PAUSE MODE II

- 1. PRESS THE "PLAY/PAUSE" BUTTON TO START PLAYBACK, THE FIRST TRACK OF THE FIRST DISC WILL BE PLAYED AND THE PLAY INDICATOR WILL APPEAR ON THE LCD DISPLAY.
- 2. OR PRESS EITHER THE " DISC 1 " , " DISC 2 " , " DISC 3 " BUTTON, UNIT WILL PLAY THE DISC INSIDE THE DESIRE TRAY DIRECTLY.
- 3. TO INTERRUPT, PRESS THE "PLAY/PAUSE" BUTTON ONCE, AND THE DISPLAY WILL START FLASHING. PRESS AGAIN TO RELEASE & RESUME PLAYBACK.

#### STOP MODE

1. IF "STOP" BUTTON IS PRESSED DURING PLAY OR PAUSE MODE, SYSTEM WILL GO TO STOP MODE.

#### SKIP MODE (SKIP UP►)/SKIP DOWN

- 1. DURING PLAY OR PAUSE MODE, IF " SKIP + " BUTTON IS PRESSED IT WILL GO TO NEXT TRACK AND DISPLAY THE TRACK NO. AND THEN REMAIN THE PLAY OR PAUSE MODE.
- 2. DURING PLAY OR PAUSE MODE, IF " SKIP " BUTTON IS PRESSED. IT WILL GO BACK TO THE PREVIOUS TRACK AND REMAIN THE PLAY OR PAUSE MODE.

#### SEARCH MODE (SEARCH UP ►► SEARCH DOWN ◀ )

- 1. DURING PLAY MODE, IF " SEARCH + " BUTTON IS PRESSED & HOLD FOR FEW SECONDS, IT WILL START SEARCHING FORWARD.
- 2. DURING PLAY MODE, IF " SEARCH " BUTTON IS PRESSED & HOLD FOR FEW SECONDS. IT WILL STAR SEARCHING BACKWARDS.

#### NOTE: UNIT WILL GO TO MUTE MODE DURING SEARCHING

Stylus assembly

#### **REPEAT PLAY**

THIS FUNCTION ALLOW TO REPEAT 1 SINGLE TRACK, 1 SINGLE DISC OR ALL DISCS PRESS THE " REPEAT " KEYS REPEATEDLY TO SWITCH THE FUNCTION



**NOTE**: SINGLE TRACK REPEAT FUNCTION IS POSSIBLE IN NORMAL OR PROGRAMMED PLAYBACK, REPEAT ONE DISC OR ALL DISCS IS ONLY AVAILABLE IN NORMAL PLAYBACK.

#### RANDOM PLAY

YOU CAN LISTEN ALL THE TACKS OF ONE SINGLE DISC IN A RANDOM ORDER BY THIS FUNCTION

- 1. PRESS "RANDOM" BUTTON ONCE DURING CD STOP/PLAYBACK MODE, UNIT WILL PLAY THE 1<sup>ST</sup>
- AVAIALBLE DISC IN RANDOM ORDER, AND THE "RANDOM "SIGN APPEAR ON THE LCD DISPLAY.
- 2. PRESS " STOP " BUTTON TO CANCEL THE RANDOM MODE.

#### CD PROGRAMMING (BY REMOTE CONTROL)

UP TO 32 TACKS CAN BE PROGRAMMED, CAN BE PLAYED IN ANY REQUIRED ORDER FROM ONE CD OR ALL CDs IN THE CD CHANGER.

- 1. SET IN CD MODE.
- 2. PRESS THE MEMORY BUTTON
- 3. PRESS THE " (DISC) " TO SELECT THE DESIRED DISC.
- 4. PRESS SKIP ₩ OR ▶ BUTTON TO SELECT THE DESIRED TRACK.
- 5. PRESS THE " MEMORY " BUTTON AGAIN TO STORE THE TRACK IN MEMORY.
- 6. REPEAT STEPS 3 TO 5 TO ENTER ADDITIONAL PROGRAM
- 7. PRESS PLAY/PAUSE BUTTON TO START PLAYBACK IN ORDER.
- 8. PRESS "STOP" BUTTON TO STOP PLAYBACK AND PRESS AGAIN TO CLEAR ALL PROGRAMMED TRACKS.

# TAPE DECK

#### **GENERAL OPERATION**

#### STOP / EJECT KEY

• PRESS TO STOP ALL DECK OPERATION. PRESS AGAIN TO OPEN THE CASSETTE DOOR.

#### **FAST FORWARD**

• PRESS TO START, FAST FORWARD WINDING THE TAPE.

#### FAST REWIND

PRESS TO START, FAST REWIND WINDING THE TAPE.

#### PLAY

• PRESS TO START PLAYING TAPE.

# PAUSE

• PRESS TO STOP TAPE OPERATION TEMPORARILY. PRESS AGAIN TO RESUME PLAY.

#### RECORD

PRESS TOGETHER WITH PLAY KEY TO START TAPE RECORDING. (TAPE DECK 1 ONLY)

# PLAYBACK

- SELECT "TAPE "FUNCTION
- PUT IN THE CASSETTE TAPE.
- PRESS PLAY KEY TO ACTIVE PLAYBACK
- ADJUST THE VOLUME CONTROL TO THE DESIRED LEVEL.
- USE PAUSE KEY WHEN YOU WANT TO STOP PLAYBACK TEMPORARILY.
- PRESS STOP / EJECT KEY WHEN FINISHED.

# RECORDING

#### A. RECORDING FROM TAPE (DECK 2 TO DECK 1)

THIS UNIT ENABLES YOU TO DUPLICATE A PRE-RECORDED TAPE TO ANOTHER TAPE. IT IS PERFORMED ONLY ONE WAY FROM DECK 2 (PLAYBAK) TO DECK 1 (RECORDING).

#### DUBBING AT NORMAL SPEED

- SELECT " TAPE " FUNCTION.
- INSET A PRE-RECORDED CASSETTE INTO DECK 2 AND A BLANK CASSETTE TAPE INTO DECK 1.
- PRESS THE "PAUSE " KEY AND THEN PRESS THE " RECORD " AND " PLAY " KEY AT DECK 1.
- PRESS THE "PLAY " KEY TO START PLAYBACK AT DECK 2 & THEN PRESS " PAUSE " KEY AT DECK 1 TO START DUBBING.
- PRESS " PAUSE " KEY AT DECK 1 & " STOP " KEY AT DECK 2 WHEN FINISH.

#### DUBBING AT HIGH SPEED

THIS UNIT IS QUIPPED WITH A HIGH SPEED DUBBING SYSTEM WHICH CAN SAVE THE TIME FOR DUBBING BY 2/3 WHEN COMPARE TO NORMAL SPEED.

- PRESS THE DUBBING BUTTON TO " HI " POSITION AND THEN FOLLOW THE SAME PROCEDURES AS STIPULATED IN "DUBBING AT NORMAL SPEED".
- WHEN DUBBING A PRE-RECORDED CASSETTE TAPE AT HIGH SPEED, A CHATTERING SOUND IS BEING HEARD. TO AVOID THIS, SET THE VOLUME CONTROL TO A MINIMUM LEVEL.
- DO NO ACTIVE/DE-ACTIVE THE "HI-NOR. DUBBING" BUTTON DURING DUBBING, THIS WILL VARY THE SPEED OF RECORDING AND MAY BE DAMAGE THE CASSETTE TAPE.

#### **B. RECORDING FROM RADIO**

- SELECT "RADIO" FUNCTION
- TUNE TO THE DESIRED STATION AND INSERT A BLANK CASSETTE TAPE IN DECK 1.
- PRESS "RECORD" & "PLAY" KEY TO START RECORDING.
- PRESS "PAUSE" KEYS AND THEN "STOP/EJECT" KEY WHEN FINISH.

#### C. RECORDING FROM CD

- SELECT "CD" FUNCTION.
- INSERT A BLANK CASSETTE TAPE IN DECK 1 WHICH SUITABLE FOR RECORDING.
- PRESS "PAUSE" KEY FIRST AND THEN "RECORD" & "PLAY" KEY AT CASSETTE. RECORDING FUNCTION IS NOW STAND BY.
- ACTIVATE THE CD PLAYER, AND THEN PRESS "PAUSE KEY" AT CASSETTE TO START RECORDING.
- TO STOP RECORDING, PRESS "STOP" BUTTON ON CD PLAYER FIRST, THEN PRESSES THE "PAUSE" KEY AND THEN "STOP/EJECT" KEY ON CASSETTE TAPE DECK.


# STYLUS

- Regularly check and remove any build-up of fluff from the stylus to prevent it from skidding and jumping across the disc surface.
- When transporting the unit always fit the stylus head protector and secure the ARM using the ARM clamp,
