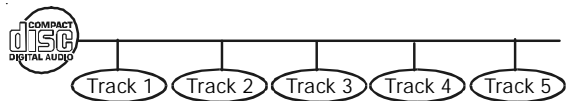
- When playing back a CD-G (Graphics) or CD EXTRA disc, the audio portion will be played, but the graphic images will not be shown.

## Title, Chapter and Tracks

- DVDs are divided into “titles” and “chapters”. If the disc has more than one movie on it, each movie would be a separate “title”. “Chapters” are sections of titles.



- Audio CDs are divided into “tracks”. A “track” is usually one song on an Audio CD.



### Note :

- Numbers identify each title, chapter, and track on a disc. Most discs have these numbers recorded on them, but some do not.

### Notes on Unauthorized Discs

You may not be able to play back some DVD discs on this unit if they were purchased from outside your geographic area or made for business purposes.

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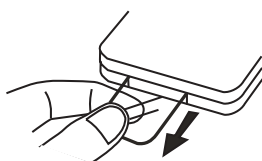
# REMOTE CONTROL

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## **Using the Remote Control**

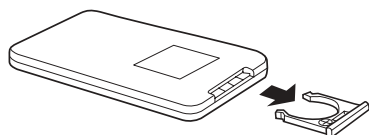
- Point the Remote Control at the REMOTE SENSOR located on the unit.
- When there is a strong ambient light source, the performance of the infrared REMOTE SENSOR may be degraded, causing unreliable operation.

Take out the PVC sheet before operating the Remote Control.

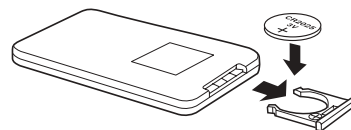


## **TO CHANGE REMOTE BATTERY**

1. Open the battery door.



2. Insert one CR2025 (3V) size battery.



## **BATTERY REPLACEMENT**

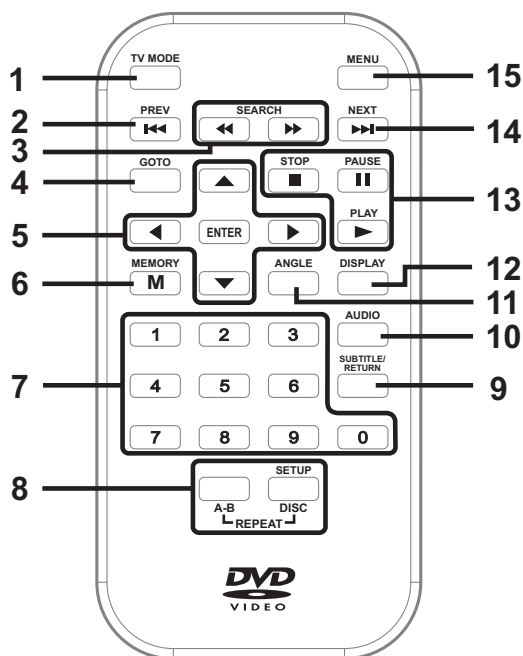
When battery becomes weak, the operating distance of the Remote Control will greatly reduced and you will need to replace the battery.

### **Notes:**

- If the Remote Control is not to be used for a long time, remove the battery to avoid damage caused by battery leakage corrosion.
- **WARNING:** Do not dispose of battery in fire, battery may explode or leak.

# CONTROL REFERENCE GUIDE

## Remote Control



### 1) TV MODE button

When the STOP button has been pressed, this feature allows you to select TV shape format. Pan Scan, Letter Box or Wide-screen will be toggled by pressing this button once.

### 2) ◀◀ PREV button

Move back through titles, chapters or tracks on a disc.

### 3) ◀◀ / ▶▶ SEARCH buttons

◀◀ SEARCH: Fast reverse playback.

▶▶ SEARCH: Fast forward playback.

### 4) GOTO button

Skip directly to a location on a DVD.

### 5) Cursor (▼, ▲, ◀, ▶) buttons

Use to highlight selections on a menu screen and adjust certain settings.

#### ENTER button

Confirm selections on a menu screen.

### 6) MEMORY button

In stop mode, enter the number of a selected chapter or track.

### 7) Number (0 - 9) buttons

Use when creating programmes, and entering a parental level password. Also use to select a CD track directly.

### 8) SETUP button

In stop mode, open and close the SETUP menu.

#### REPEAT A-B button

Perform point-to-point repeat playback on a DVD or CD.

#### REPEAT DISC button

Repeat chapter or title of a DVD.

Repeat single track or whole CD.

### 9) SUBTITLE button

Select one of the subtitle languages programmed on a DVD.

#### RETURN button

Return to the normal operation after using the SETUP menu of a DVD.

### 10) AUDIO button

Select one of the audio sound tracks programmed on a DVD or select the audio output mode on an AUDIO CD.

### 11) ANGLE button

Switches between multiple camera angles when the DVD you are playing has multiple camera angles recorded.

### 12) DISPLAY button

Change disc status information displayed on the screen.

### 13) ■ STOP button

Stop playing a disc.

#### ■ PAUSE button

Pause playback, frame advance.

#### ▶ PLAY button

Press to start or resume playback a disc.

### 14) ▶▶ NEXT button

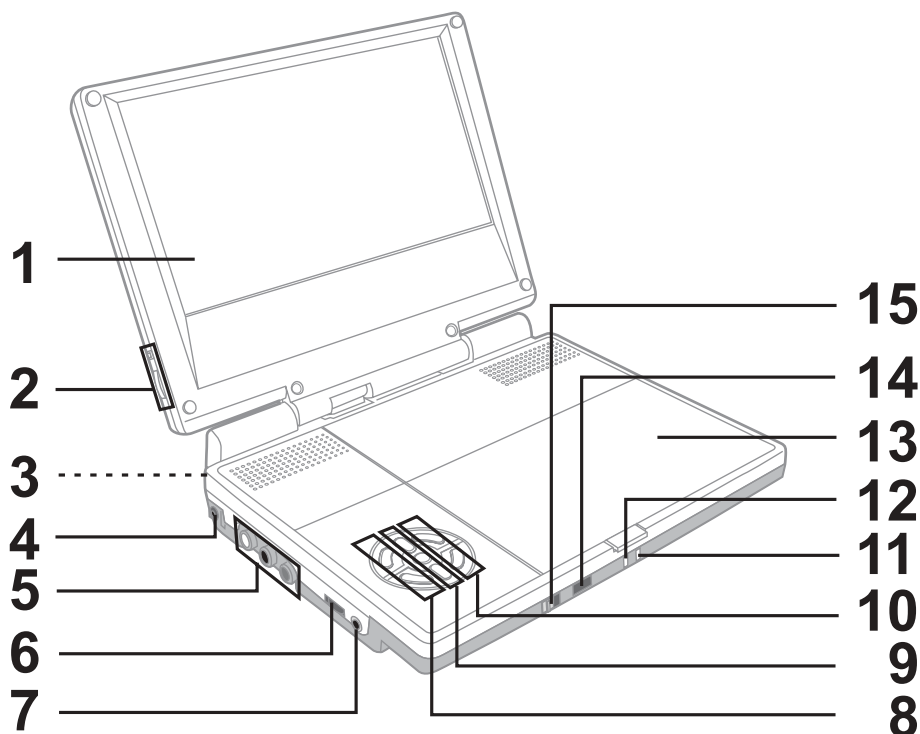
Move forward through titles, chapters or tracks on a disc.

Open and close DVD menu.

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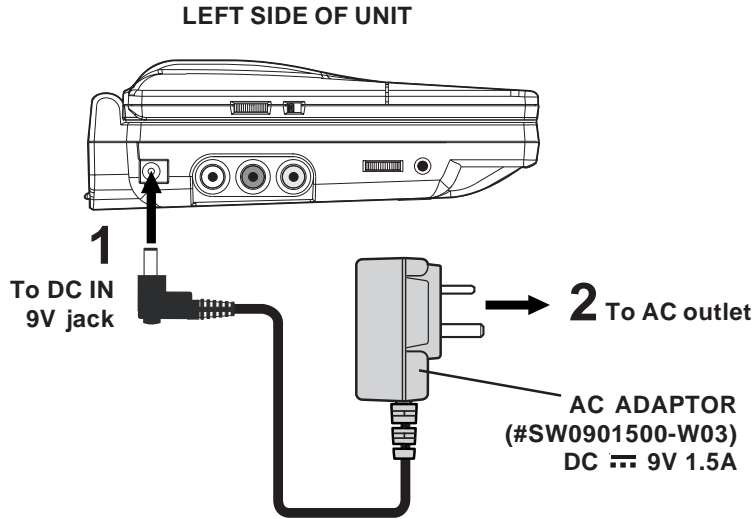
# POWER SUPPLY

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## A. Using the AC adaptor

This AC adaptor operates on AC between 100V and 240V.

- The supplied AC Adaptor is suitable for use on AC mains supplies of 100-240 Volts AC and should only be connected to a mains supply within these parameters.



### CAUTIONS:

- The included AC adaptor is for use with this unit only. Do not use it with other equipment.
- When the unit is not going to be used for long time, disconnect the AC adaptor from the AC outlet.

### IMPORTANT

- Be sure to use it near the wall outlet. If a malfunction occurs, disconnect the plug from the wall outlet at once.
- When the AC adaptor is plugged in, the apparatus is not completely disconnected from the mains, even when the power is turned off.

### WARNINGS:

- AC adaptor is used as the disconnect device. It shall remain readily operable and should not be obstructed during intended use. To be completely disconnected the apparatus from supply mains, the AC adaptor of the apparatus shall be disconnected from the mains socket outlet completely.

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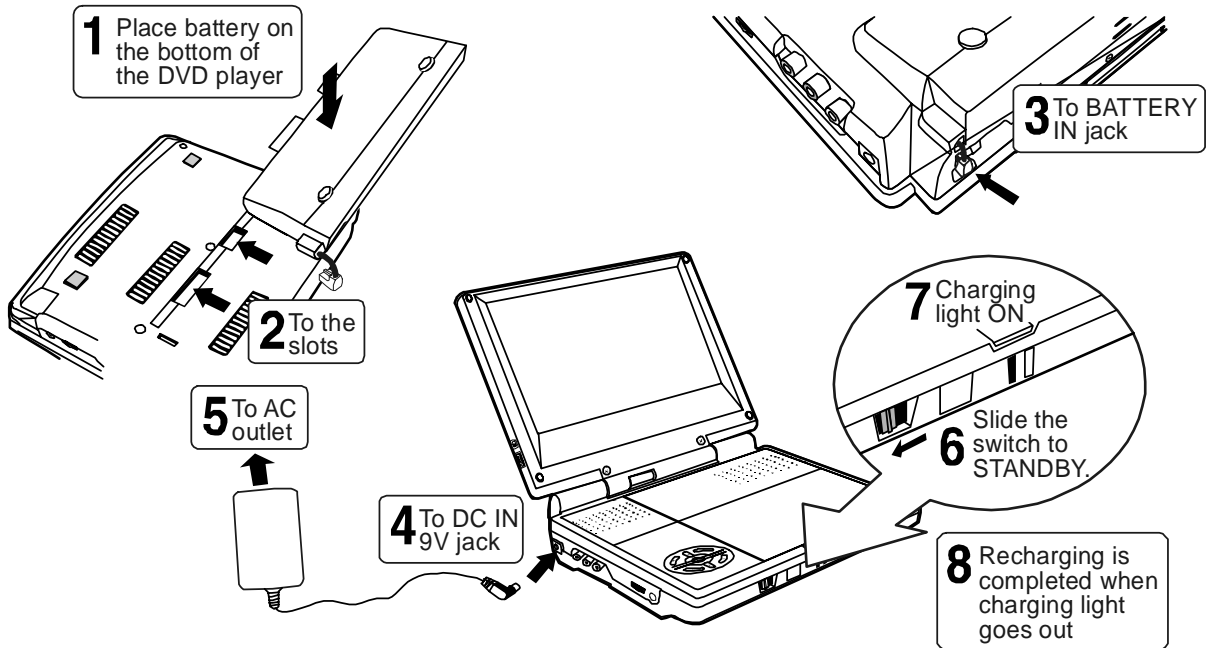
# POWER SUPPLY

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## ***B. Using the rechargeable battery***

- Charge the rechargeable battery before using it for the first time. The normal charging time should be completed at least 4-5 hours. The green charging light will go out when the battery becomes fully charged.
- The rechargeable battery is suitable when adapting the unit for portable use and when it is convenient for you to enjoy the unique functions of the unit out of doors.

### **To recharge the battery**



### **Warning:**

- The battery can only be recharged when the unit is OFF and using the AC adaptor supplied.

### **Cautions:**

- The battery can only be recharged when the unit is OFF and using the AC adaptor supplied.
- When the unit is not going to be used for long time, disconnect the AC adaptor from the AC outlet.
- When the AC adaptor is plugged in, the apparatus is not completely disconnected from the main, even when the power is turned off.

### **Condition and attention:**

- When battery is low, player will stop playing.
- Do not short-circuit the terminals.
- Recharge the battery when you are ready to use it again.
- While using the rechargeable battery, the environmental temperature should be 5°C (41°F) to 35°C (95°F).
- To get the longest service life of the rechargeable battery, charge at indoor-temperature.
- Never dispose the battery in fire or water. Never heat up the rechargeable battery.
- Do not open the rechargeable battery, refer servicing only to qualified service personnel.

## ***Turning on the unit***

1. Slide the **STANDBY/ON** switch on the front of the unit to the "ON" position.
2. The DVD logo (start-up picture) will appear on the screen.



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# CONNECTIONS

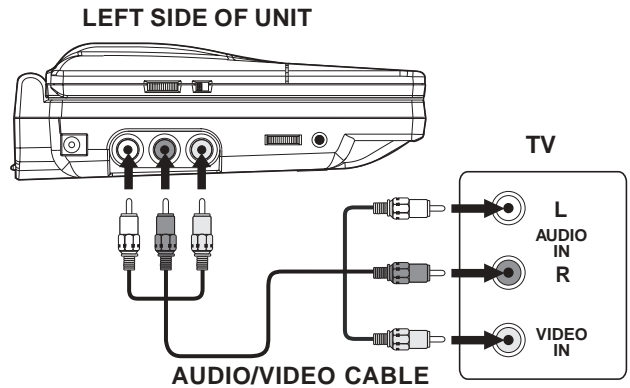
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## A. Connecting a TV

- If your TV has Audio/Video inputs, you can also connect the unit to your TV using the Audio and Video cables.

### Watching a DVD on your TV

1. Turn on the unit.
2. Turn on the TV and follow the instructions included with it to play the DVD.



## B. Using Headphones / Earphones

- Turn down the volume before connection, and then adjust the level.
- When headphones / earphones are connected, no sound will be output from the unit's speaker.

### Caution:

- Avoid listening to sound at levels which may be harmful to your ears.



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# SOUND SYSTEM


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## Dolby Digital

This owner's manual explains the basic instructions for operating this unit. Some DVDs are produced in a manner that allows specific or limited operation during playback. Therefore, this unit may not respond to all operating commands. **THIS IS NOT A DEFECT.** Please refer to the instructions accompanying the specific DVD in question for more information about the options available on that DVD.

“” may appear on the screen during operation. A “” means that the desired operation is not permitted by the unit or disc.

### Playing a Disc

1. Slide the **STANDBY/ON** switch on the front of the unit to the ON position.

See **CUSTOMIZING THE FUNCTION SETTINGS** before proceeding to step 2.

2. Open the disc door.

3. Hold the disc by its sides and carefully place it onto the spindle with the label side facing up, pushing gently until you hear a “click”.

4. Close the disc door.

It takes a short while for your unit to load the disc. After loading, the unit will automatically either bring you to the main menu of the DVD, or start playing the DVD.

5. If the unit does not automatically start playing the DVD, press the **▶ PLAY** button.

#### Note:

Some Video CD are recorded with **PBC (Playback Control)**, a menu with recorded contents may appear on the TV if you have turned the PBC on. You can make your selection according to its PBC menu. Press the **MENU** button on the remote control to turn PBC on and off anything during you are playing back a Video CD.



### Pausing playback (still mode)

Press the **⏸ PAUSE** button. To resume normal playback, press the **▶ PLAY** button.

Each time you press the **⏸ PAUSE** button, the picture advances one frame.

### Stopping playback

Press the **■ STOP** button at the location where you want to interrupt playback. To resume playback at the position where the disc was stopped, press the **▶ PLAY** button.

If you press the **■ STOP** button twice, the unit's memory will be cleared and pressing the **▶ PLAY** button will reset the disc to the beginning.

### Skipping to a different track

- Press the **⏮ PREV** button repeatedly to skip to the start of the current or previous track.
- Press the **⏭ NEXT** button to skip to the next track.
- For audio CDs, use the number buttons on the remote control to jump immediately to the desired track number.

### Fast Forward/Fast Reverse

1. Press the **SEARCH ▶▶** or **◀◀ SEARCH** button when a disc is playing.

• The disc begins a fast scan at two times normal (x2) speed.

• Four speeds are available. Each time the **SEARCH** button is pressed, the speed of the fast scan changes in the following sequence:

X 2 ▶▶ → X 4 ▶▶ → X 8 ▶▶ → X 20 ▶▶

↑

2. Press the **▶ PLAY** button when you reach the desired point to resume playback at normal speed.

### SKIP (Forward / Reverse)

While you are playing a disc, press the **⏭ NEXT** button to move to the beginning of the next chapter or track. Press the **⏮ PREV** button to move to the previous chapter or track and automatically start playing it.

# PLAYING A DISC



## Audio selection

On some discs, the sound is recorded in two or more formats. Follow the directions below to select the type of playback.

1. While a disc is playing, press the **AUDIO** button to show the current audio format number.
2. Press the **AUDIO** button repeatedly to select the desired audio format.

: 1/3 ENG 6CH

### Notes :

- If only one audio format is recorded, the number does not change.
- About two seconds later, playback continues in the new audio format.

## Subtitle selection

1. While a DVD is playing, press the **SUBTITLE / RETURN** button to display the current language setting, as shown in the example below.
2. Press the **SUBTITLE / RETURN** button repeatedly to select the desired subtitle language.

: 2/3 ESP

### Notes :

- If only one language is recorded, the language does not change.
- About two seconds later, playback continues with the new subtitle you selected.
- The number of languages recorded differs depending on the disc.
- If no button is pressed within a few seconds, playback continues without changing the current subtitle.
- This function can only be used for discs on which subtitles have been recorded in multiple languages.
- On some DVDs, subtitles are activated from the main menu of the DVD. Press the **MENU** button to activate the main menu.

## Angle selection

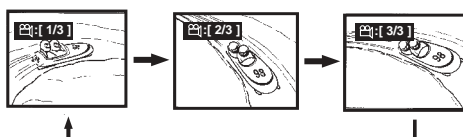
Some DVDs contain scenes which have been shot from a number of different angles. For these discs, the same scene can be viewed from each of these different angles.

1. While you are playing a DVD with different angles recorded, press the **ANGLE** button to view the number of the current angle available.

: [ 2/3 ]

2. Press the **ANGLE** button repeatedly to change the scene to the next recorded angle.
  - After approx. two seconds, playback will continue from the new angle you selected.
  - If no button is pressed within 10 seconds, playback continues without changing the current angle.

### Sequence of angle shots (Example)



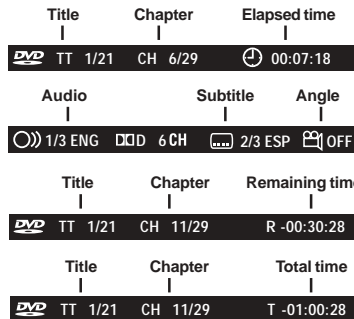
### Notes:

- This function can only be used for discs on which scenes shot from multiple angles have been recorded.
- If only one angle is recorded, “Angle: [ 1/1 ]” is displayed.

## DISPLAY function

Using DISPLAY, you can check the current settings of the following items: ANGLE, AUDIO and SUBTITLE.

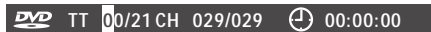
- While the disc is playing, press the **DISPLAY** button to display the screen shown below.



## Locating a specific title

If a DVD contains title numbers, you can locate a specific title by directly selecting its title number.

1. In stop mode, press the **GOTO** button.
2. Press **◀** or **▶** button to highlight a specific field and press the corresponding number button(s) for the title you want.
3. Press the **ENTER** button to confirm. The unit will start playback about 3 seconds later.



## Locating a specific chapter / track

If you know the chapter/track number for the chapter/track that you want to play, you can locate it by directly selecting that number.

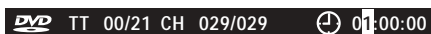
1. Press the **GOTO** button to search for your desired chapter/track.
2. Press **◀** or **▶** button to highlight a chapter/track and press the corresponding number button(s) for the chapter you want.
3. Press the **ENTER** button to confirm. The unit will start playback about 3 seconds later.



## Locating a specific time

You can move to a specific location by entering its corresponding time (hours, minutes, seconds)

1. Press the **GOTO** button.
2. Press **◀** or **▶** button to highlight time.
3. Press the corresponding number buttons for the setting point you want.
4. Press the **ENTER** button to confirm. The unit will start playback about 3 seconds later.



### Notes :

- Some discs may not respond to this process.
- Some scenes may not be located as precisely as you specified.
- This method for accessing specific locations is available only within the current title of the DVD disc.

# CD/DVD PROGRAMMABLE MEMORY

## Programmable memory

The two types of programmed playback provided by this Unit are title/chapter programmed playback and track programmed playback.

### Title/Chapter programmed playback

1. Press the **MEMORY** button while the disc is stopped.
2. Enter the title numbers in **■**. Use **◀** or **▶** button to highlight your desired chapter and enter the chapter numbers in **■**.
3. Use **◀**, **▶**, **▲** or **▼** button to move to another field.
4. Repeat steps 2 to 3.
5. Press the **▶ PLAY** button to start the programmed playback.

1. Press the **MEMORY** button while the disc is stopped.
2. Enter the track numbers in **■**.
3. Use **◀**, **▶**, **▲** or **▼** button to move to another field.
4. Repeat steps 2 to 3.
5. Press the **▶ PLAY** button to start the programmed playback.

## REPEAT PLAYBACK



You can play a specific title or chapter repeatedly.  
(Title repeat, chapter repeat, A-B repeat)

### Repeating a chapter

You can play the same chapter repeatedly.

1. While the disc is playing, press the **REPEAT DISC** button until the "**REP: CHAPTER**" indicator displays on the screen. The current chapter is played repeatedly.

### Repeating a title

You can play the same title repeatedly.

2. While the disc is playing, press the **REPEAT DISC** button until the "**REP: TITLE**" indicator displays on the screen. The current title is played repeatedly.

### To resume normal playback

3. While the disc is playing, press the **REPEAT DISC** button until the "**REP: OFF**" indicator displays on the screen.

You can play a single track or the whole DVD repeatedly.

### Repeating a single track

You can play the same track repeatedly.

1. While the disc is playing, press the **REPEAT DISC** button until the "**REP: REP 1**" indicator displays on the screen. The current track is played repeatedly.

### Repeating a whole disc

2. While the disc is playing, press the **REPEAT DISC** button until the "**REP: REP ALL**" indicator displays on the screen. The whole disc is played repeatedly.

### To resume normal playback

3. Press the **REPEAT DISC** button until the "**REP: OFF**" indicator displays on the screen.

### Repeating a specific section

You can play a specific section repeatedly.

1. While the disc is playing, press the **REPEAT A-B** button at the beginning of the section ((**REPEAT A-**) is displayed) you want to play repeatedly.
2. Press the **REPEAT A-B** button again at the end of the section ((**REPEAT A-B**) is displayed).
3. The Unit will immediately begin replaying your selection.

### To resume normal playback

4. While the disc is playing, press the **REPEAT A-B** button until the "**A-B CANCEL**" indicator displays on the screen.

### Notes:

- A-B repeat can only be used within the same title. If the start and end of the section to be repeated are in different titles, A-B repeat is cancelled.
- The A-B repeat function does not operate in scenes where different camera angles are recorded.

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## PLAYING A PICTURE FILE DISC

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This unit can play a Picture files recorded on CD-R and CD-RW discs.

### ***Playing a Picture file disc***

1. Open the disc door.
2. Hold a Picture file disc by its edge and gently push it onto the spindle with the label side facing up you until you hear a "click".
3. Close the disc door.
4. The unit will load the disc and automatically display the contents of the disc on the screen, while also beginning to play the first Picture files. These files will then be played back one by one.
5. Press ◀ or ▶ button to select to play a PICTURE file.
6. Press the ▲, ▼, ◀ or ▶ **CURSOR** button to view and select the files that you want to listen to, then press the **ENTER** button to confirm the selected file.

### **Notes:**

- You can press the **II PAUSE** button to interrupt playback, and press the **▶ PLAY** button to resume playback.
- You also can use the **GOTO** function or use the numbered buttons to enter a photo number and quickly select any image.
- Press the **ANGLE** button on the remote control to rotate the picture orientation by 90°.

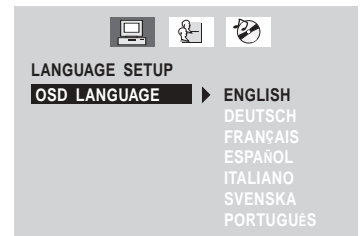
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## CUSTOMIZING THE FUNCTION SETTINGS

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### **LANGUAGE SETUP**

1. Press the **SETUP** button in stop mode.
2. Use ▶ button to change the highlight cursor. Use ▲ or ▼ button to select a language, then press the **ENTER** button. The screen will change to your selected language immediately.
3. To exit the SETUP MENU and return to the normal screen, press the **RETURN** or **SETUP** button.

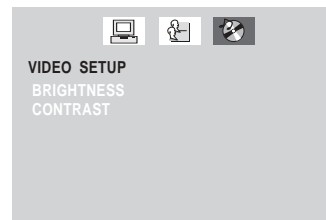




# CUSTOMIZING THE FUNCTION SETTINGS

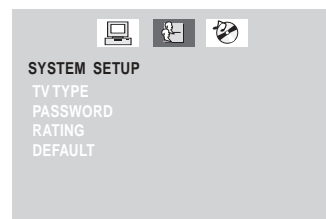
## VIDEO SETUP

1. Press the **SETUP** button in stop mode.
2. Use **▲** button to **LANGUAGE SETUP**, then press **◀** or **▶** button repeatedly until the **VIDEO SETUP** appear.
3. Use **▲** or **▼** button to select the option (BRIGHTNESS or CONTRAST), then press the **▶** button. Use **▲** or **▼** button to be adjusted, then press the **ENTER** button. (The screen will change to your selected setting.)
4. Repeats step 2 and 3 above to adjust other option.
5. To exit the SETUP MENU and return to the normal screen, press the **RETURN** or **SETUP** button.



## SYSTEM SETUP

1. Press the **SETUP** button in stop mode.
2. Use **▲** button to **LANGUAGE SETUP**, then press **◀** or **▶** button repeatedly until the **SYSTEM SETUP** appear.
3. Use **▲** or **▼** button to select the option (TV TYPE, PASSWORD, RATING or DEFAULT), then press the **▶** button. Use **▲** or **▼** button to be adjusted, then press the **ENTER** button. (The screen will change to your selected setting.)
4. Repeats step 2 and 3 above to adjust other option.
5. To exit the SETUP MENU and return to the normal screen, press the **RETURN** or **SETUP** button.



## TV Type

### Pan Scan

- When wide-screen video is played, this mode clips the right and left sides of the image so that it can be viewed on a conventional screen.
- Some wide-screen DVDs that do not permit Pan Scan mode playback are automatically played in letterbox mode (black bands top and bottom).

### Letter Box

- When wide-screen video is played in this mode on a conventional screen, black bands appear at the top and bottom of the screen.

### Wide-screen

- This is the correct mode for playing wide-screen videos on a wide-screen.

### Notes :

- The visible picture size is preset on the DVD disc. Therefore the playback picture of some DVD discs may not conform to the picture size you select.
- When you play DVD discs recorded in the 4:3 aspect ratio, the playback picture will always appears in the 4:3 aspect ratio regardless of the TV shape setting.

## Password

Use **▲** or **▼** button to shift and select Password, enter your 4-digit security code and then press the **ENTER** button.

**If you forget the password, you can erase your current password by pressing number button 8 on the remote four times, then press the ENTER button to confirm the setting (PASSWORD : 8 8 8 8).**

## Rating

DVD discs equipped with a password function and are rated according to their content. The contents allowed by parental lock level and the way a DVD disc is controlled may vary from disc to disc. For example, if the disc allows, you could lock-out violent scenes unsuitable for children or you could lock out playback of the disc altogether.

**You cannot play DVD discs rated higher than the level you selected unless you cancel the parental lock function.**

The parental lock levels are equivalent to the following ratings.

Level 1 : Safe	Level 5 : PG-R
Level 2 : G	Level 6 : R
Level 3 : PG	Level 7 : NC-17
Level 4 : PG-13	Level 8 : Adult

### Note :

It takes 3-5 seconds to reset the unit to the factory default.

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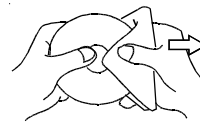
# MAINTENANCE

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## **Cleaning Disc**

A defective or soiled disc inserted into the unit can cause sound to drop out during playback. Handle the disc by holding its inner and outer edges.

- Do NOT touch the surface of the unlabeled side of the disc.
- Do NOT stick paper or tape on the surface.
- Do NOT expose the disc to direct sunlight or excessive heat.
- Clean the disc before playback. Wipe the disc from the center outward with a cleaning cloth.
- NEVER use solvents such as benzine or alcohol to clean the disc.
- Do NOT use irregular shape discs (example : heart shaped, octagonal, etc.). They may cause malfunctions.



## **Cleaning the unit**

- Be sure to turn the unit off and disconnect the AC adapter before maintaining the unit.
- Wipe the unit with a dry soft cloth. If the surfaces are extremely dirty, wipe clean with a cloth which has been dipped in a weak soap-and-water solution and wrung out thoroughly, then wipe with a dry cloth.
- Never use alcohol, benzine, thinner, cleaning fluid or other chemicals. Do NOT use compressed air to remove dust.


## **Important Note**

- Before transporting the unit, remove any disc from the disc compartment.

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# TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

The remote control does not function.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Remove any obstacles between the remote and the unit.</li><li>• Use the remote near the unit.</li><li>• Point the remote at the remote sensor on the unit.</li><li>• Replace all the battery in the remote with new ones.</li></ul>
<b>DVD</b> No sound or only a very low-level sound is heard.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Make sure that you select DVD mode.</li><li>• The system is in pause mode. Press the ► <b>PLAY</b> button to return to normal play mode.</li><li>• The unit is in fast-forward or fast-reverse mode. Press the ► <b>PLAY</b> button to return to normal play mode.</li><li>• Make sure that AUDIO / VIDEO output connections are correct.</li><li>• The unit is too hot, shut off the unit for 30 minutes to cool it down.</li></ul>
No picture	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The region number of the disc doesn't match the region number of this unit. </li></ul>
The picture is not clear	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Clean the disc.</li><li>• The disc is scratched.</li></ul>
Severe hum or noise is heard.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The plugs and jacks are dirty. Wipe them with a cloth slightly moistened with alcohol.</li><li>• Clean the disc.</li></ul>
The disc does not play.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• There is no disc inside ("No Disc" appears on the screen).</li><li>• Insert the disc correctly with the playback side facing down.</li><li>• Clean the disc.</li><li>• A non-valid disc has been inserted. The unit and disc region number are incompatible.</li><li>• Condensation may have formed inside the unit due to a sudden change in temperature. Wait about an hour for it to clear and try again.</li></ul>
