Introduction

Thank you for buying this GTVL15W18HDVF TV which is designed to give you many years of trouble-free servic You may already be familiar with using a television but do please take time to read these instructions. They are designed to familiarise you with the unit's many new features and to ensure you get the very best out of your purchase.

Safety is Important

Your safety and the safety of others is important. Please, therefore, ensure you read the Safety instructions on p before you operate this GTVL15W18HDVF TV.



NOTE: This 15.4" LCD TV is referred to throughout this user guide as TV.

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Safety Precautions

Please read all the safety information before use.

Safety Considerations

- Position the power supply lead so that it cannot be walked on or pinched by items placed on or against it.
- Do not use the TV in humid or damp conditions.
- Do not allow the TV to get wet.
- Do not expose the TV to splashing or dripping.
- Do not expose the TV to naked flames.

Power Source

You should only plug the TV into a 230V to 240V AC,50Hz supply.

High Voltage

- Do not remove the rear cover as high voltage components are accessible.
- Disconnect the TV from the power supply when the TV is not to be used for a prolonged period of time.

Cleaning

- Disconnect the TV from the power supply before you clean it.
- Do not use liquid or aerosol cleaners.
- Clean your TV with a soft, damp(not wet) cloth.

Ventilation

- The slots and openings on the TV are for ventilation. Do not cover or block them as it may cause overheating.
- NEVER let children push anything into the holes or slots on the case.

Servicing

- There are no user serviceable parts in this TV.
- When servicing, refer to qualified service personnel.
- Consult your dealer if you are ever in doubt about the installation, operation or safety of this TV.


Electrical Information

This appliance is fitted with a BS1363/A 13 amp plug. If it is not suitable for your supply sockets it must be removed and replaced with an appropriate plug. If the plug becomes damaged and/or needs to be replaced please follow the wiring instructions below. The plug removed must be disposed of immediately. It must not be plugged into a supply socket as this will be an electrical hazard.

If the fuse needs to be replaced it must be of the same rating and ASTA approved to BS1362. If the plug is changed, a fuse of the appropriate rating must be fitted in the plug, adapter or at the distribution board. If the fuse in a moulded plug is replaced, the fuse cover must be refitted before the appliance can be used.


Wiring Instructions

The supply cable will be either 2-core or 3-core. Follow the appropriate wiring instructions given on the next page. In both cases ensure that the outer sheath of the cable is firmly held by the cable clamp.

Remove your TV carefully from the box. You may wish to store the packaging for future use.






The Remote Control

Inserting Remote Control Batteries

- 1.On the back of the remote control, push up the catch on the battery compartment cover and lift to remove it.
- 2.Insert the two AAA batteries, ensuring that you follow the polarity diagram inside the battery compartment.

3. Refit the cover

Switching On

Mains Power

Complete all connections before connecting to the mains supply.

Connect the aerial to Aerial Socket. Connect the adapter block to the DC IN socket Insert the mains plug into the mains socket.

Switch the mains power on.



NOTE: When not in use, disconnect the 3-pin plug from the mains power supply.

When the TV is successfully connected to the power supply, the standby indicator on the front of the TV will illuminate red. The TV is now in standby mode and the screen remains blank.

Press the **STANDBY** button on the side of the TV or the power button on the remote The standby indicator on the front of the TV will turn green and the picture will appear after a few seconds.

Identification of Controls

Front

1.Standby

Switches the TV to stand-by and on again. The TV is only completely disconnected from the mains if the plug is disconnected.

2.Menu

Activates the On-screen menus.

3. Volume Up/Down

Volume adjust buttons. Also used to move left and right whilst navigating on-screen menus.

4. Programme Up/Down

Channel select buttons.
Also used to move up
and down whilst navigating
on-screen menus.

5.INPUT

Cycles through the available input sources.

- 6.Speakers
- 7 Remote Control Sensor
- 8. Standby Indicator
- 9.Stand



Identification of Controls

10 PLAY

Press to play the DVD playing.

11 PAUSE

Press to pause the DVD playing.

12 STOP

Press to stop the DVD playing.

13 NEXT

Press to advance forward to the next chapter.

14 PREVIOUS


Press to replay the current program from the pre-vious chapter.

15 Eject

Press to Eject button to take the disc out



Tuning the TV

First Time Installation

The following screen will appear, Initial Channel Search will scan for, sort and save any available channels.

INITIAL CHANNEL SEARCH

ENSURE AERIAL CONNECTED TO TV

SELECT YES AND PRESS MENU TO CONTINUE

- 1.Press the LEFT/RIGHT ARROW buttons to highlight YES.
- 2.Press **ENTER** to start analogue auto search. Once the progress bar has filled any channels found will be stored and the unit will proceed to the search for digital chanels.



- 3. The following screen will appear.
- 4. Press **LEFT/RIGHT ARROW** button to highlight **Confirm.**

Do you want to start digital search?

5. Press **ENTER** button to start digital search. All available digital channels found will automatically be stored into the channel list.



Menu Navigation

The basic controls needed to go through the menu screens are as follows:

- 1. Press the **TV SETUP** button to cycle through the On-screen menu.
- 2. Press the **UP/DOWN ARROW** buttons to move up and down the On-screen menus.
- 3. Press the **LEFT/RIGHT ARROW** buttons to move left and right when navigating the On-screen menu.

AUTO Tuning

- 1. Press the TV SETUP button 3 times to activate the TV SETUP menu.
- 2. Press the **DOWN ARROW** button to highlight **AUTO SEARCH**.
- 3. Press the **RIGHT ARROW** button the auto tuning process will begin.

This may take several minutes to complete. Once complete the TV will tune to the first channel.



NOTE:To receive a TV signal, you can use an outdoor or indoor aerial. However, If you live in a poor reception area you may experience loss or corruption of teletext transmissions or may not receive a signal at all when using an indoor aerial.



Channel Position

The automatic tuning may not store the channels in the order you require. For example, BBC1 might be stored in channel position 4 and Channel 4 might be stored in channel position 1. Using the **TV SETUP** menu, channel positions can be swapped to obtain the correct order.

After you have performed an auto tune(see previous page);

- 1. Press the TV SETUP button 3 times to activate the TV SETUP menu.
- 2. Press the **DOWN ARROW** button to highlight **SWAP**.
- 3. Press the **RIGHT ARROW** button to enter the swap menu.
- 4. Select the first channel using the **LEFT/RIGHT ARROW** buttons.
- 5. Press the **DOWN ARROW** button.
- 6. Select the second channel using the **LEFT/RIGHT ARROW** buttons.
- 7. Press the **DOWN ARROW** button to highlight **SWAP**.
- 8. Press the **RIGHT ARROW** button to swap the two channels you just selected.
- 9. Press the **DTV MENU**button to exit the On-screen menu.





MANUAL Tuning

- 1.Press the TV SETUP button 3 times to activate the TV SETUP menu.
- 2. Press the **DOWN ARROW** button to highlight **MANUAL SEARCH**.
- 3.Press the **RIGHT ARROW** button and the below will be shown. Select either **UP** or **down** and press the **RIGHT ARROW** button to search **up** or **down** the available frequencies for the next channel.



Fine Tuning

The auto scan and manual scan will tune to the strongest signal, however, if the reception is not good you can try to fine tune the channel.

- 1. Press the TV SETUP button 3 times to activate the TV SETUP menu.
- 2. Press the **DOWN ARROW** button to highlight **FINE TUNE**.
- 3. Press the **RIGHT/LEFT ARROW** button to adjust the frequency and fine tune the channal.



Using the TV

TV Controls


Programme Selection

You can use the controls on either the TV or remote control to select channels.

Press the **CH+/-** buttons on the TV or remote control, or press a **NUMBER** button on the remote control to select a programme.

Volume

Press the **VOL+/-** buttons on the TV or remote control to adjust the volume.



Mute

- 1.Press the **MUTE** button on the remote control to mute the sound. The mute symbol will be shown in the top left hand corner of the screen.
- 2. Press the **MUTE** button again to restore the sound. The mute symbol will disappear from the screen.




NOTE: Pressing the **VOL+** button will also restore the sound.

Display

- 1. Press the **DISPLAY** button on the remote control. Information will appear on screen giving the user settings and channel information. It depends on the input selected...
- 2. Press the **DISPLAY** button again to remove the information from the screen.

Mono/Stereo

1. Press the NICAM button to switch between MONO or STEREO reception.



Picture Preset

The TV has four preset conditions that alters all the options to give a different picture quality.



NOTE: The Picture Preset function is not available through navigation of the on screen menus.

Press the **PMODE** button repeatedly to scroll through and select one of the following. options:

STANDARD -Used for general viewing.

- FRESH Used for brighter image with strong colouring.
- * PERSONAL -Used defined settings.
- MILD -Used for a softer image with weaker colouring.
- FRESH, PERSONAL, STANDARD and MILD will appear at the bottom of the screen.

Input selection

Press the **TV SETUP** button repeatedly to scroll through and select one of the following. input options:

- TV RF Signal(TV Aerial)
- SCART Signal from the SCART socket
- AV Signal from AV sockets
- PC-RGB Signal from PC-RGB socket
- YPBPR Signal from YPBPR (Component)sockets
- HDMI Signal from HDMI socket
- DTV RF Signal(TV Aerial)
- DVD Signal form COAX Socket



Using Teletext

Teletext is an information system that displays text on your TV screen. Using the telete control buttons you can view pages of information that are listed in the teletext index.



NOTE: No On-screen display is available in text mode. The contrast ,brightness and colour can not be changed but the volume control is still available



NOTE: Make sure the TV channel you are watching transmits teletext.


TEXT

- 1. Press the **TEXT** button to enter **TEXT** mode. The text page will appear, normally the index page.
- 2. Press the **TEXT** button again to view a page of text whilst watching a TV programme.

 The text will be superimposed over the TV programme.
- 3. Press the **TEXT** button a third time to return to the channel you were watching.

To Select a Page of Text

 Find the number of the page in the index and enter it by pressing the NUMBER buttons. The number of the page will appear in the top left hand corner of the screen.
 The page counter will search for your page. When it finds it, the page will be displayed



- 2. Press the CH+ button to move to the next page of text.
- 3. Press the CH- button to move to the previous page of text.

INDEX

Press the **INDEX** button to go to the index page.

Page Stop

If the page of text you have selected contains sub-pages, these sub-pages will automatically be displayed in order with a delay to allow you to read the page.

- 1.Press the **HOLD** button to stop the move to the next sub-page. The hold symbol will appear in the top left hand corner of the screen.
- 2. Press the **HOLD** button again to continue cycling through the sub-pages.


To Reveal Information

- 1. Press the **REVEA**L button to reveal concealed information(quiz answers etc.).
- 2. Press the **REVEAL** button again to conceal the information.

SUBPAGE

If the page of text you are viewing contains sub-pages, the number of the sub-page you are on and the total number of sub-pages is displayed on the right of the screen.

To select a sub-page, press the **SUBPAGE** button. S.... will appear in the top left hand corner of the screen.



Enter the number of the sub-page, using the **NUMBER** buttons in the format 0001 for sub-page 1. The teletext will search for the sub-page.

Fast Text

At the bottom of the teletext screen is a row of subject headings in red, green, yellow and blue.

- 1. Press one of the coloured fast text buttons on the remote control to display that page.
- 2. Press the **INDEX** button to return to the main page.

SIZE

- 1. Press the **SIZE** button to enlarge the text shown on the teletext screen. Only one half of the page is shown.
- 2. Press the **SIZE** button again to view the second half of the page.
- 3. Press the **SIZE** button a third time to return to normal size text page.



On-screen Menus

- 1. Press the **TV SETUP** button to cycle through the On-screen menus.
- 2. Press the UP/DOWN ARROW buttons to highlight one of the available options.
- 3. Press the **LEFT/RIGHT ARROW** buttons to adjust the selected option.
- 4. When finished, press the **SETUP** button repeatedly until the menu disappears or press the **DVB MENU** button to exit the main menu.



VIDEO SETUP

Your TV has four settings which allow you to control the picture quality:



Press the UP/DOWN ARROW buttons to select one of the available options.

BRIGHTNESS

Use the **LEFT/RIGHT ARROW** buttons to increase or decrease the brightness of the picture.

CONTRAST

Use the **LEFT/RIGHT ARROW** buttons to increase or decrease the contrast of the picture.

COLOUR

Use the **LEFT/RIGHT ARROW** buttons to increase or decrease the colour saturation of the picture.



SHARPNESS

Use the **LEFT/RIGHT ARROW** buttons to increase or decrease the sharpness of the picture.

AUDIO SETUP

Your TV has several settings which allow you to control the audio quality.




VOLUME

Allows you to increase or decrease the volume.

BALANCE

Allows you to adjust the volume balance between left and right audio channels.



AUDIO PRESET

Use the LEFT/RIGHT ARROW buttons to select one of the following settings:

PERSONAL -User defined preferences.

VOICE -High treble, low bass for normal TV programming.

MUSIC -High treble, high bass for music based programming.

THEATRE -Low treble, high bass for live performances.



NOTE: It is also possible to cycle through the audio presets by pressing the **SMODE** button on the remote.

TREBLE

The treble setting adjusts the high frequency section of sound.



NOTE: The audio preset must be set to **PERSONAL** to adjust this option.

BASS

The bass setting adjusts the low frequency section of sound.




NOTE: The audio preset must be set to **PERSONAL** to adjust this option.



TV SETUP

The TV menu can be used to manually tune a station or to fine tune existing stations.



CHANNEL

Select a particular channel to apply any changes to, the selected channel will be shown in the background.

CHANNEL NAME

Use this option to adjust the channel name shown when changing channels.



SKIP

If you set this option to ON the channel will not be available using the **CH+/-** buttons however can still be accessed when using the **NUMBER** buttons..

AFC

To reach the exact frequency, Set the AFC(Auto Frequency Control) option to ON.

FINETUNE

Allows you to fine tune the channel to obtain the best picture quality.

SWAP

Using the SWAP option, channel positions can be swapped to obtain the correct order

MANUAL SEARCH


Allows you to preset channels manually, in the program order of your choice (for details of manual search please see page 19)

AUTO SEARCH

This option will automatically search for analogue TV transmissions and attempt to store them in the correct order .During searching, you can press **DTV SETUP** to stop searching, and when finished the TV will change to **DTV**(Digital TV) mode. If no DTV channels are stored it will ask you to confirm that you wish to search for DTV channels



GENERAL SETUP



BLUE SCREEN

Activating the Blue Screen will ensure a clear, solid, blue screen is shown when no signal is being received.

Press the LEFT/RIGHT ARROW button to turn the BLUE SCREEN on or off.

NOISE REDUCE

If the signal you receive is has a snowy effect, This feature may reduce the signal noise and improve clarity of the picture.

Press the LEFT/RIGHT ARROW buttons to set NOISE REDUCE to OFF/LOW/MID / HIGH.



INPUT SOURCE

Press the **LEFT/RIGHT ARROW** buttons to select the input you want to display.

TV - Analogue TV Signal(TV Aerial)

SCART - Signal from the SCART socket

AV - Signal from AV sockets

PC-RGB - Signal from PC-RGB socket

YPBPR - Signal from YPBPR(component) socket

HDMI - Signal from HDMI socket


DTV - Digital TV Signal(TV Aerial)

DVD - Signal from COAX Socket

NOTE: The input source can also be cycled by pressing the **IN PUT** button repeatedly on the remote control.

RESET

Press the RIGHT ARROW button to restore all settings to their factory default value.



Digital TV (DTV)

Turn on your TV set and select **DTV** input by pressing the **INPUT** key on the remote repeatedly until **DTV** is shown on the screen





Channel Search

During the First time installation process you will be given the opportunity to search for Digital channels after searching for the analogue channels. In the unlikely event that this does not happen or if you need to re-scan in case new channels have been added, the following procedure can be used.


Auto Scan

- 1) Press the DTV MENU button to enter the main menu of the DTV.
- 2) Press the UP /DOWN ARROW button to choose Channel Search
- 3) Press the **ENTER** button to enter the sub-menu.
- 4) Highlight the **Search Type** and press **LEFT/RIGHTARROW** button to select **Auto scan**.
- 5) Press the ENTER button to start searching.
- 6)Press DTV MENU button to cancel searching.







Manual Scan

Recommended for advanced users only. If you know the UHF channel number that a set of digital channels are located at, the manual search can be used to add only these channels.

- 1)Press the **DTV MENU** button to enter the main MENU of the **DTV**.
- 2)Press the UP/DOWN ARROW button to select Channel Search
- 3)Press the ENTER button to enter the sub-menu
- 4)Highlight the **Search Type** and press **LEFT/RIGHT ARROW** button to select **Manual scan**. Press **DOWN ARROW** button to select **Channel No** section, and enter desired Channel Number.
- 5)Press **DOWN/UP ARROW** button to select "**Channel No**" section, and enter desired Channel Number.
- 6)Press the **ENTER** button to start searching.
- 7)Press **DTV MENU** button to cancel searching.





NOTE:
When the search isfinished, the first channel in the channellist is displayed you can now watch digital terrestrial televison.



Changing Channels

There are five ways of channel selection as follows:

1)Stepping through the channel list:

Press the **CH+** button to browse up and the **CH-** button to browse down the available channels.

2)Selection by number:

Enter the complete channel number directly using the numerical buttons to select desired channel.

3)Selection by on-screen channel list:

You can also select the desired channel directly from on-screen channel list. This is displayed using the DTV main menu. Please See **CHANNEL LIST** later in this manual for the further details.

4) Selection by mini channel list:

It is also possible to change the channel using a mini channel list that is accessible by pressing the **ENTER** button with no other on screen display shown. Use the **UP/DOWN ARROW** keys to navigate and press the **ENTER** button to display the selected channel. To exit this mini channel list press the **DTV MENU** button.





Changing Channels

5)Selection by TITLE:

You can also select the desired channel directly from Channel Schedule. This is displayed by pressing the **TITLE** button on the remote control. The **TITLE** provides the users with a brief description of the programme on the currently selected channel and lists the current channels. Please See **Accessing the TITLE** in this manual for further detail.

After changing channels either by entering the number directly or by stepping through the channle list, the I-Bar will be shown. This will display the current and the next program for the selected channels. The current signal strength will also be shown on the I-Bar. The I-Bar can also be displayed by pressing the **MENU** button with on other on screen display. H





Accessing the EPG (Electronic Programme Guide)

From the TITLE it is possible to check the program information for the next 7 days (if the information is available from the broadcaster).) and also set reminders to automatically change channel for a specific event using the following instructions.


- 1) Press the TITLE button to display the EPG
- 2) Press CH + or CH button to change the channel that the information listed is shown for.
- 3)Press **LEFT/RIGHT ARROW** button to change the day that the information is shown for.
- 4)Press UP /DOWN ARROW button to highlight the desired program. If this program is being currently being shown, press the ENTER button and the EPG will close and this programm will be shown.



Accessing the EPG (Electronic Programme Guide)

- 5)If the program is in the future, press the **ENTER** button to add the reminder, the will appear alongside the selected program. When the reminder program is about to start, a reminder window will appear.
- 6)Press MENU button to quit the channel schedule.





Channels List

The Channel List will display a list of the digital channels that are stored on the TV. From the Channel List you can preview and listen to a selected channel, delete them from the list, and lock a channel so that a PIN number is required to view the channel.

- 1)Press DTV MENU button to enter the main menu.
- 2)Press **UP/DOWN ARROW** button to highlight Channel List, and press **ENTER** button to enter **Channel List** menu.
- 3)Press UP/DOWN ARROW button to highlight a channel.
- 4)Press ENTER button to preview the selected channel.
- 5)Press DTV MENU button to exit the channel list menu and view the channel full screen







Lock/Unlock a channel:


- 1) Enter the channel list menu, press **UP/DOWN ARROW** button to select the channel to be locked/unlocked.
- 2)Press Blue button, you are asked to enter pin code



- 3)Enter a correct pin code using the numeric buttons, press **ENTER** button to confirm. (The default pin code is 888888).
- 4)Then a lock symbol channel displays alongside the selected channel.
- 5) Repeat step (1)(2)(3) to remove the lock symbol.
- 6)Press DTV MENU button to exit from the channel list.

Delete a channel:

- 1)Enter the channel list menu, press **UP/DOWN ARROW** button to select a channel.
- 2)Press Yellow button to delete the selected channel.



Subtitles

Press the **SUBTITLE** button repratedly to cycle through the available subtitle languages. The on-screen display will show briefly the language of the selected subtitles. To remove the subtitles press the **SUBTITLE** button repeatedly until **Subtitles off** is shown on the on-screen display. Please note that only the languages that are being broadcast for the current programm will be available.

Audio

Press the AUDIO button repeatedly to cycle through the available audio languages. The on-screen display will show briefly the language selected for the audio. Please note if "AD" follows the language shown on the on-screen display(for example English AD") this is the audio descriptor audio, the normal audio from the program will not be heard, instead there will be description of the scene shown on the TV when there there is a break in the normal audio.

Digital Teletext

Some digital channels have a digital version of the traditional teletext service. Usually if the channel that you are viesing has this digital teletext there will be an on-screen display showing how this service can be accessed. For most channels that have this digital teletext service is accessed by pressing the **RED** or **TEXT** button. Once started follow the on -screen instruction to navigate througt the available information. The standard navigation method is using the UP/DOWM/LEFT/RIGHT AR-ROW buttons and the ENTER button. Some services will offer shortcuts via the coloured buttons on the remote.



System Setting

First Time Installation

This menu allows you to delete all existing channels in the memory

- 1)Enter the system setting menu, press **UP/DOWN ARROW** button to highlight the **First Time Installation**
- 2 Press ENTER button to confirm, a confirmation window appears.
- 3)Press **LEFT/RIGHT ARROW** button to highlight **Confirm** icon, press **ENTER** button to start first time installation The instructions for automatic channel search can then be followed
- 4) Highlight the **EXIT** icon ,press **ENTER** button to cancel the first time installation.





System Info:

- Enter the SYSTEM SETTING menu, press UP/DOWN ARROW button to highlight the System Info option.
- 2)Press **ENTER** button to display the system information. You can view the software version of the DTV.




Change Pin Code

This menu allows you to change pin code.

- 1) Enter the SYSTEM SETTING menu, press UP/DOWN ARROW button to highlight the Change Pin Code option.
- 2) Press ENTER button.
- 3) Enter the old pin code using the numeric buttons (Default pin code is 888888).
- 4) Press **UP/DOWN ARROW** button to select **New Pin Code** and enter new pin code using the numeric buttons(0~9).



Region code

If the region code of the disc being played does not match the region code of this DVD player then the disc cannot be played.

The region code for this player is region 2 (refer to the symbols opposite).









Inserting a Disc



NOTE: To operate the **DVD** player form the remote control you must first repeatedly press the **INPUT** button so that **DVD** is displayed in the top right hand comer of the screen.

- Gently push the disc into the slot on the left side of the TV/DVD with the label facing towards you. The mechanism will take the disc into the player.
- 2. "Close" and "Read" will be displayed.





Playing DVDs

The film may start automatically you may be presented with a menu screen, this is dependent on the way the DVD disc has been created by the movie company.

Pause Play

Troubleshooting
